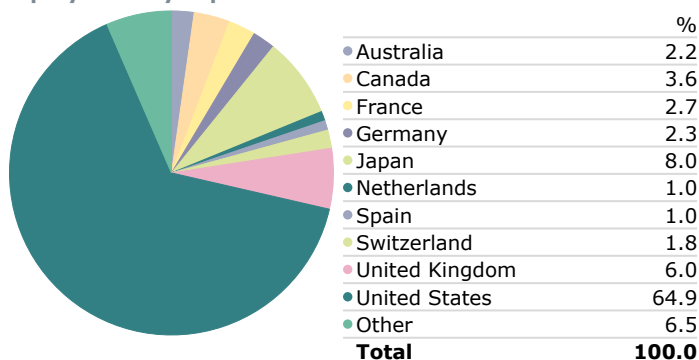

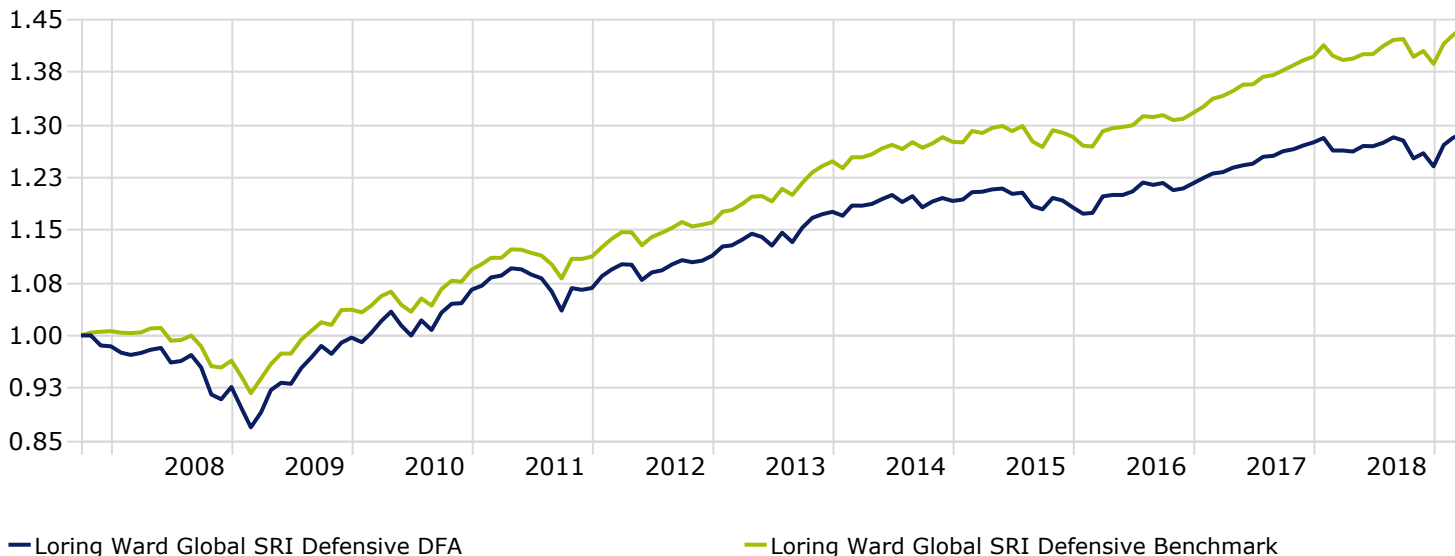

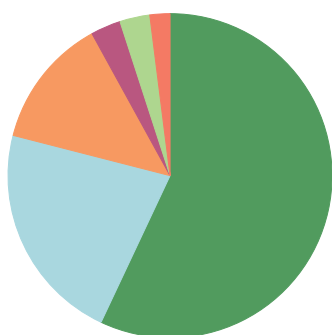

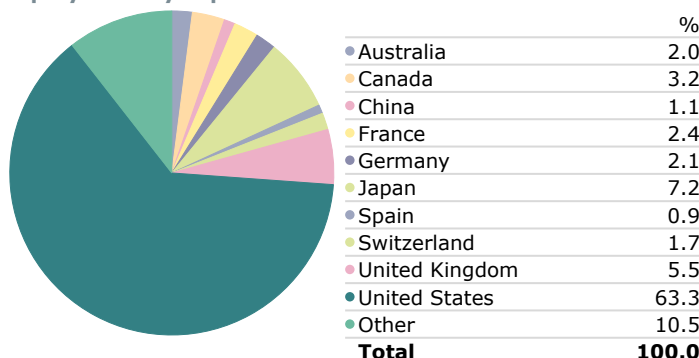

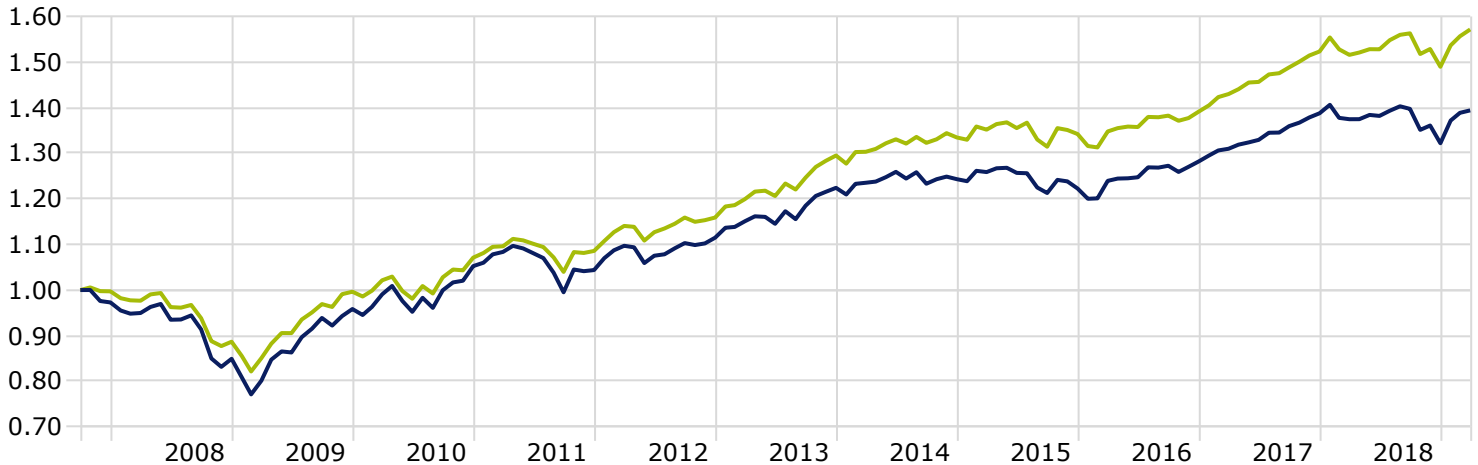

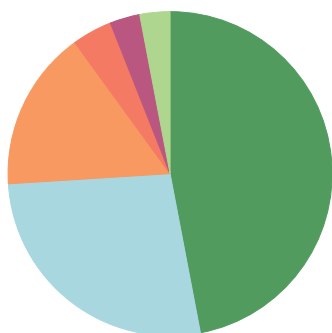

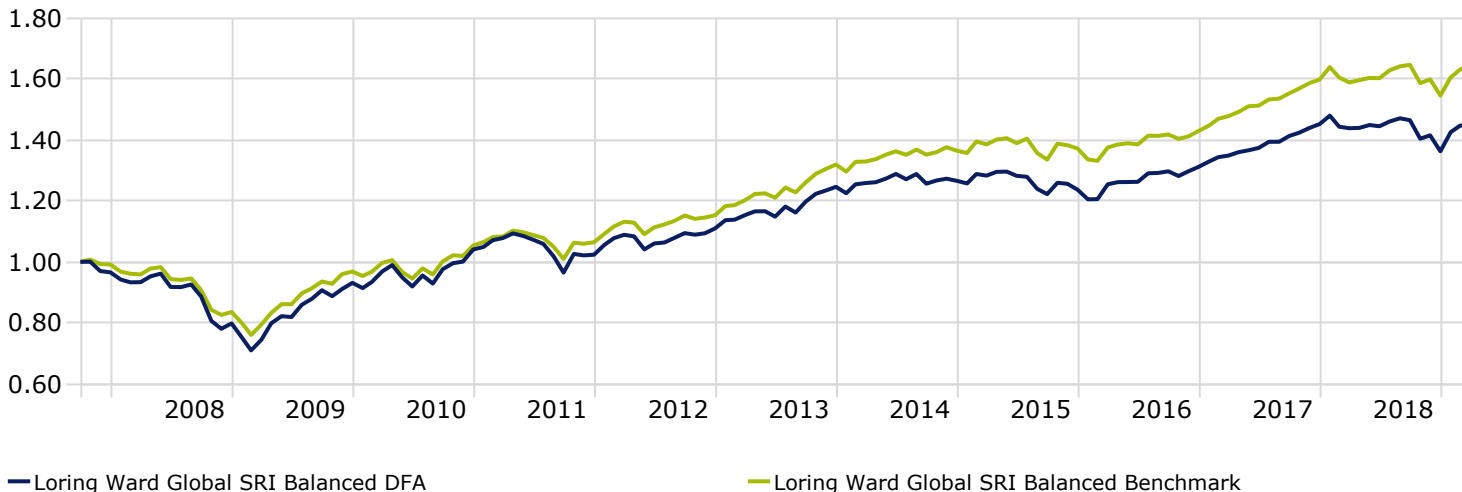

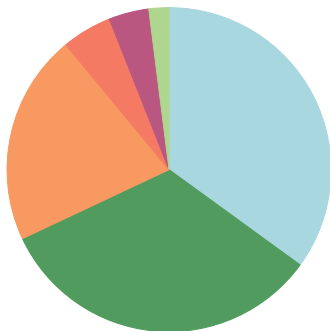

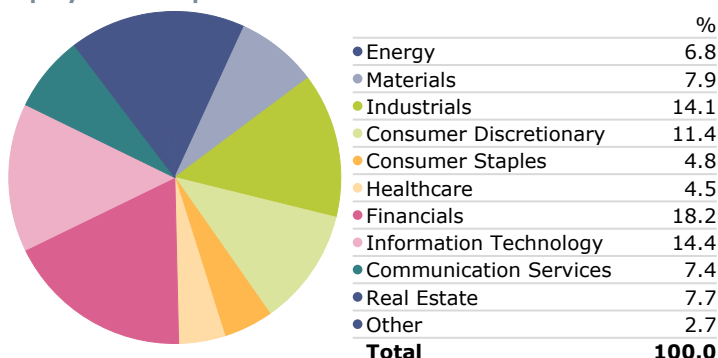

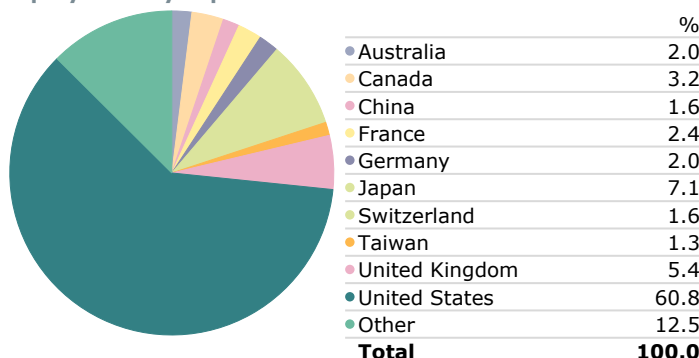

Equity Sector Exposure

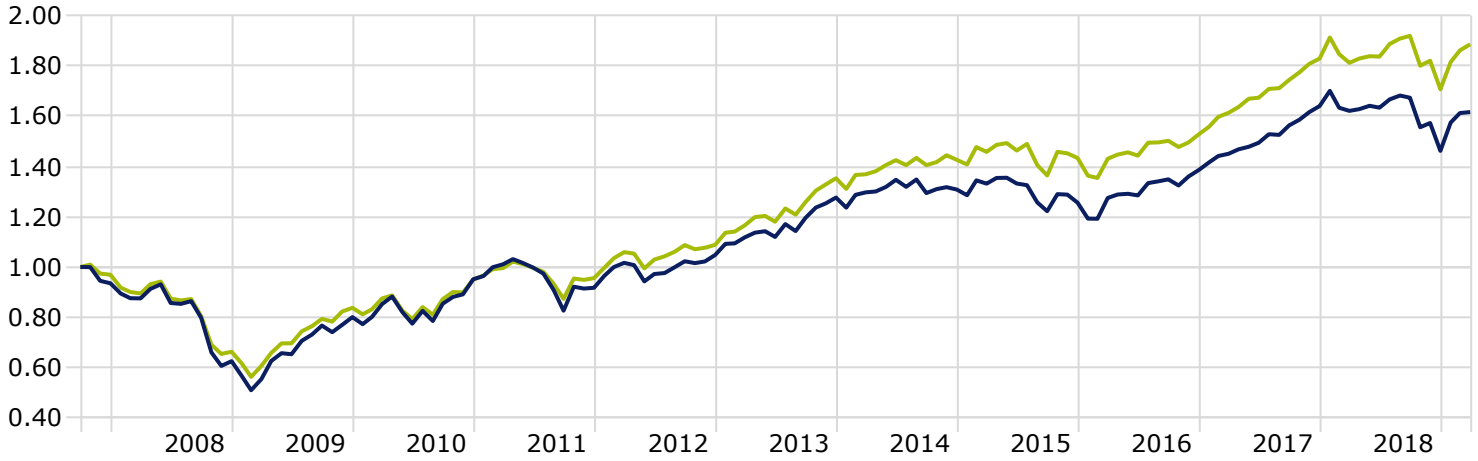


Equity Country Exposure

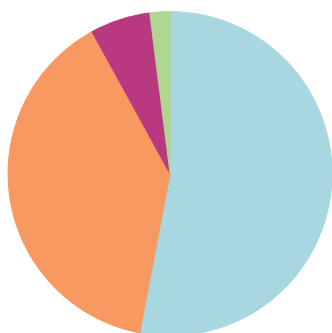

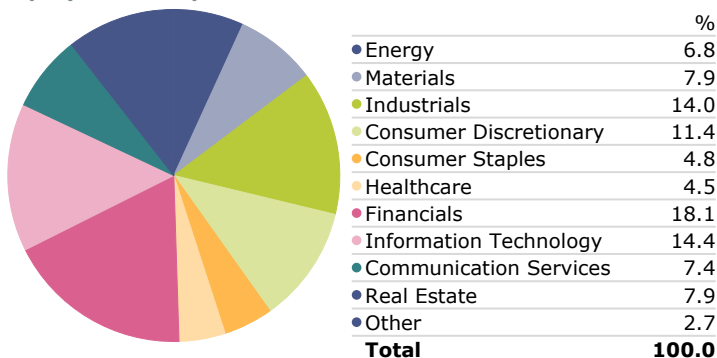

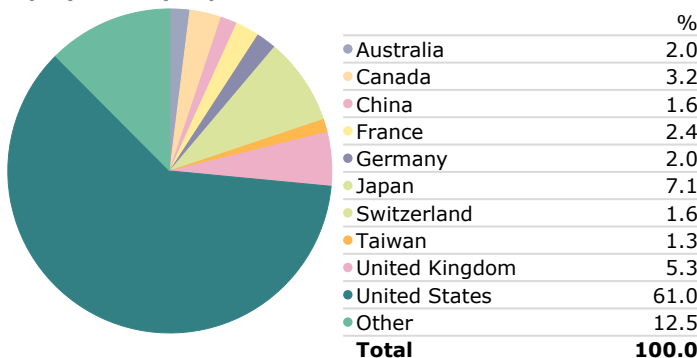

Equity Sector Exposure

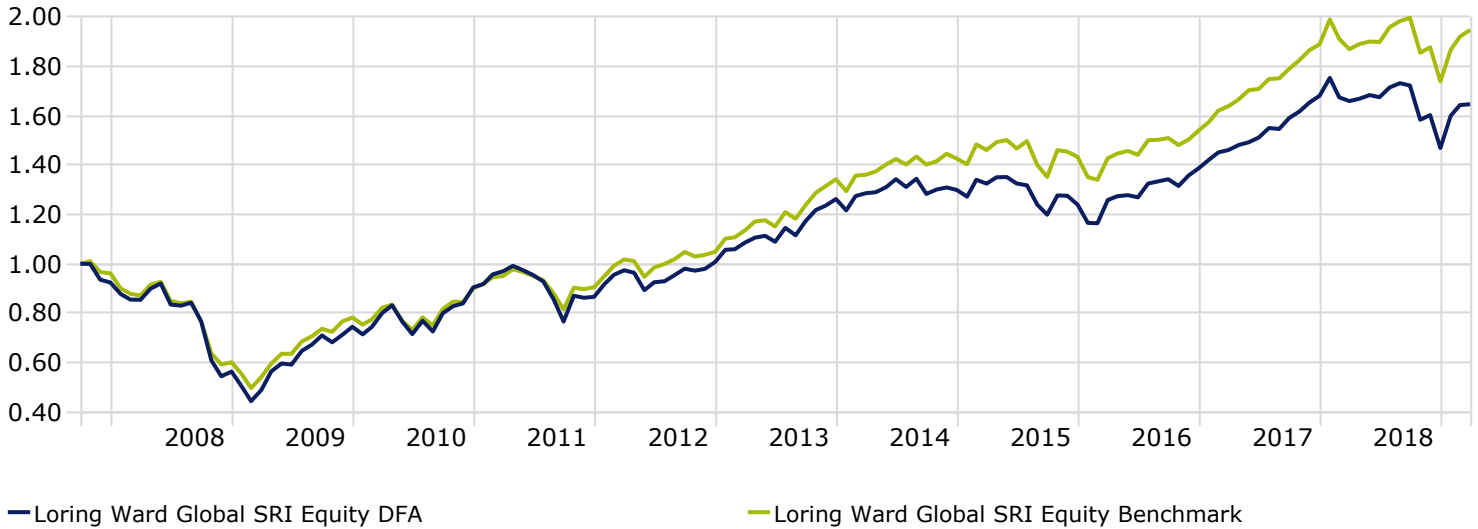


Equity Country Exposure
