



The Fund's goal is to achieve long-term capital appreciation. The Fund pursues its goal by generally investing in a broad and diverse group of readily marketable equity securities of small cap companies listed on a securities exchange in the United States that is deemed appropriate by the Sub-Adviser. The Sub-Adviser considers small cap companies to be companies whose market capitalizations generally are either in the lowest 12.5% of total market capitalization or companies whose market capitalizations are smaller than the 1,000th largest U.S. company, whichever results in the higher market capitalization threshold. Under the Sub-Adviser's market capitalization guidelines described above, based on market capitalization data as of August 31, 2020, the market capitalization of an eligible company would be approximately \$11 billion or below. This dollar amount will vary due to market conditions. The Fund has a non-fundamental investment policy that, under normal circumstances, it will invest at least 80% of its net assets in securities of U.S. small cap companies.
